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Day 1 **D**

School to Adelaide

Day 2 **B/L/D**

Adelaide to Coober Pedy

Today we wake up and head out of Adelaide and make our way towards Coober Pedy where we start to get a look in to the Australian outback. Once arriving at Coober Pedy we will enjoy a town tour and opal cutting demonstration and get a real experience of sleeping underground



Day 3 **B/L/D**

Coober Pedy to Alice Springs

Today we say good bye to coober pedy and head further north in to the northern territory. stopping at Sturt Well for the opportunity to ride a camel. \$\$

Then pushing on to Alice Springs where we will set up camp for the next two nights. Then we head in to town for some free time and then to Anzac Hill lookout for nibbles and enjoy sunset.

Day 4 **B/L/D**

Alice Springs

This morning we enjoy a much needed sleep in, before enjoying the day touring around Alice Springs. We visit

- School of the air
- Royal flying doctors service
- Alice Springs reptile centre
- Stanley chasm
- Simpsons gap

Day 5 **B/L/D**

Alice Springs to Watarrka

After a hearty breakfast we head out to Watarrka, where we will enjoy a short walk in to the Garden of Eden and enjoy some free time at our accommodation (option of helicopter flights at own expense).



Day 6 **B/L/D**

Watarrka to Uluru

This morning we walk the Watarrka National Park and explore the spectacular sandstone cliffs, natural rock pool, and lush vegetation of the Garden of Eden and view the Lost City. The next three nights will be at the Uluru Campground. Before dinner tonight we visit the Sunset Strip to witness the sunset over the "Rock". (Note entry into the park is an additional cost per person over the age of 16 years – staffs are included in your tour price)

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Day 7 **B/L/D**

Kata Tjuta National Park

This morning we meet our local guide and travel out to kata Tjuta where we will enjoy a walk around the valley of the winds then head back to the resort to enjoy the afternoon off.

Day 8 **B/L/D**

Uluru

Uluru National Park is listed as a World Heritage Area and from 348 metres above the ground wonder at the enormity of the Australian Outback. Once again our local guide will show us around the rock as we do the base walk. Then we visit the culture centre where get a great insight to the traditional owners of the Uluru. Then we head back to the resort where we have a celebration and enjoy our last night in the red centre.



Day 9 **B**

Uluru to Melbourne (Air)

This morning we pack our camp up for the last time and enjoy our breakfast. We say good bye to our driver and cook as they drop us off at the Ayres rock airport to fly back to Melbourne.

Accommodation:
